### REALIZING THE DIFFERENCE

Understand who exactly you should hire for your business needs:

- Web Designers creates the layout and design of a website
- **UX/UI Designers** elaborates the entire end-to-end journey of a user's interaction with a product
- **Graphic Designers** creates visual concepts of digital products

## DEFINING DESIGNATION REQUIREMENTS

Determine a clear list of needs that eventually will help you get specific design services and choose the most relevant cooperation model.

CREATING A PROPER JOB DESCRIPTION

Prepare a detailed and concise description of employee responsibilities, needed skills, benefits of working with you, etc.

## SEARCHING FOR CANDIDATES AND PORTFOLIO ASSESSMENT

Use social media and specialized platforms (Behance, Dribbble, ArtStation, DesignRush) to find suitable candidates and evaluate their work.



#### INTERVIEWING CANDIDATES

Present your company and/or the project the designer will work on; assess his or her hard & soft skills; experience, strengths and weaknesses, etc.

#### MAKING AN OFFER

Formalize everything negotiated during the interview in a formal letter; clearly define the terms of cooperation.

Integrate your new employee into the team by supplying him or her with the tools and information necessary for quick adaptation.
